



## *M.S.B. Blanca*

### **TASTING NOTES:**

**Appearance/Colour:** White wine with a pale yellow color and greenish reflections. Agile in the glass exhibiting a clean and bright appearance.

**Aromas/Nose:** On the nose, it is intense, with aromas of white fruits like pear and melon, with a floral predominance of white roses and notes of fennel, over a slightly spicy and mineral background.

**Flavors/Palate:** On the palate, it is direct, vibrant, fresh, and well-balanced. The flavors of white fruits reappear, along with a marked minerality and a prolonged aftertaste, enriched by subtle wood notes from aging in acacia barrels.

### **STORY OF THE WINE**

Blanca is a white wine that we produce in Corbera d'Ebre, within the Terra Alta Designation of Origin, the global mecca of White Grenache, with a limited production of fewer than 1,000 bottles per vintage.

Blanca is bottled honestly. This white wine, aged for 8 months in 500 liter Acacia Barrels, seeks to preserve and enhance the purity of the variety, sourced from vines over 40 years old, planted on "panal" and "tapàs" soils.

Dry, fresh, and with intense aromas and flavors of pear and melon, with a floral background, mineral hints, and a persistent finish, Blanca reveals the most vibrant side of this grape variety.

Balanced and fresh, where the acacia highlights its potential, perfectly reflecting the expression of the wine in our Mediterranean climate.
